Collective Worship Policy

The Governing Upper Batley High School adopted this collective worship policy 1st September 2015.

The aim of the collective worship policy is to provide the opportunities for learners to:

- worship;
- reflect on values;
- develop a community spirit, a common ethos and shared values;
- consider spiritual and moral issues; and
- respond to the worship offered.

The structure of collective worship at Upper Batley High School reflects the diverse ethnic population of the school as well as satisfying the requirements of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998 and the non-statutory guidance of the Kirklees Standing Advisory Council on Religious Education (SACRE).

Assemblies

Year assemblies are run during tutor time and each year group is expected to have one assembly each week. Assemblies take the form of a celebration of learners' achievements, information giving and reflection. Assemblies are usually run by Year Leaders or members of the Senior Leadership Team. Form tutors are expected to attend and contribute.

Whole school assemblies may also run at intervals within the school year and would follow a similar format the Year assemblies.
