Your son must make at least 2 sub grades progress every year and he receives extra positive sleuths for making fantastic progress (Gold progress). The more progress the more sleuths he receives! These interim grade reports are a key part of our Going for Gold achievement challenge and your son's progress is rigorously monitored throughout the school year.
